- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 1040 hours on Friday 12th September 2025 until 2359 hours on Tuesday 16th 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. A diversion will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow excavation to repair leaking main works to be carried out by United Utilites on behalf of Network Plus.
