LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (BILSBORROW LANE AND VARIOUS ROADS, INGLEWHITE, PRESTON BOROUGH) (RESTRICTED ROADS) ORDER, 1999

The County Council of Lancashire, in exercise of its powers under Sections 82(2) and 83(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. Restricted Roads

The lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Order shall be restricted roads for the purposes of Section 81 of the Act.

2. Commencement of Order

This Order may be cited as the "Lancashire County Council (Bilsborrow Lane and Various Roads, Inglewhite, Preston Borough) (Restricted Roads) Order, 1999 and shall come into force on the 18th October 1999.

SCHEDULE

- 1. Bilsborrow Lane, C350, from its junction with Silk Mill Lane, C352 and Button Street, C353, for a distance of 200 metres in an westerly direction.
- 2. Inglewhite Road, C350, from its the junction with Silk Mill Lane, C352 and Button Street, C353, for a distance of 480 metres in an easterly direction.
- 3. Silk Mill Lane, C352, from its junction with Bilsborrow Lane, C350 and Inglewhite Road, C350, for a distance of 460 metres in a southerly direction.
- 4. Button Street, C353, from its junction with Bilsborrow Lane, C350 and Inglewhite Road, C350, for a distance of 390 metres in a northerly direction.
- 5. Unnamed slip road connecting Silk Mill Lane, C352, and Bilsborrow Lane ,C350.
- 6. Unnamed slip road connecting Bilsborrow Lane, C350, and Button Street, C353.
- 7. Unnamed slip road connecting Inglewhite Road, C350, and Button Street, C353.
