### **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984** LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

(CROSTON ROAD, WHAM LANE, LONGTON, CHAIN HOUSE LANE, FARRINGTON, CHAPEL LANE, LONGTON, WHAM LANE, NEW LONGTON, SOUTH RIBBLE BOROUGH) (PART REVOCATION, 30 MPH AND 40MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2010

The County Council of Lancashire, in exercise of its powers under Section 84(1)(a) and (2) of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

## 1. Part Revocation

Those parts of the Orders specified in Schedule 1 to this Order are hereby revoked.

## 2. 30mph Speed Limit

No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour along any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.

## 3. 40mph Speed Limit

No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour along any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 3 to this Order.

## 4. Commencement of Order

This Order may be cited as the "Lancashire County Council (Croston Road, Wham Lane, Longton, Chain House Lane, Farrington, Chapel Lane, Longton, Wham Lane, New Longton, South Ribble Borough)(Part Revocation, 30 Mph And 40mph Speed Limit) Order 2010" and shall come into force on the 28<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2010.

## THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF LANCASHIRE (RESTRICTED ROADS)(NO.4) ORDER 1963

## 30 MPH Speed Restriction (restricted road)

- 1. Chapel Lane, from its junction with Liverpool Road to the eastern boundary of St Oswald's School
- 2. Wham Lane, from its junction with Station Road in an easterly direction for a distance of 300 yards

# THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF LANCASTER (RESTRICTED ROADS)(NO.7) ORDER 1969

## 30 MPH Speed Restriction (restricted road)

Chapel Lane, from a point 135 yards east of its junction with Avalwood Avenue in a south-easterly direction to its junction with Longton By Pass

#### 40 MPH Speed Restriction

Croston Road, from the Leyland Urban District Boundary to a point 50 yards south-west of its junction with Fidler Lane

### 40 MPH Speed Restriction


Wham Lane, Chain House Lane & Coote Lane, from its junction with Orchard Avenue to a point 136.5 metres west of its junction with School Lane


#### Schedule 2 – 30 MPH Speed Limit

- 1. Chapel Lane, Longton, from its junction with Liverpool Road, Longton in an easterly direction to its junction with Longton By-Pass.
- 2. Wham Lane, New Longton, from the centre line of Station Road to a point 60 metres east of the centre line of Orchard Avenue.

#### Schedule 3 - 40MPH Speed Limit

- 1. Croston Road, Farington, from a point 127 metres south of the centre line of Moss Lane to a point 47 metres south-west of the centre line of Fidler Lane.
- 2. Wham Lane, Longton and Chain House Lane, Farington from a point 60 metres east of the centre line of Orchard Avenue to the eastern kerbline of Penwortham Way.
