

LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
(D'URTON LANE, HIGHRIGG DRIVE, ST JOHN'S COURT, PRESTON, PRESTON CITY) (REVOCATION, 20, 30MPH SPEED LIMITS AND RESTRICTED ROAD) ORDER 2014

The County Council of Lancashire, in exercise of its powers under Sections 82, 83 and 84 of and Part 1V of Schedule 9 to the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order: -

1. Revocation

The "The Lancashire County Council, (40 M.P.H Speed Limit) (No. 2) Order 1984" is revoked insofar as it relates to the length of road set out in schedule 1 to this Order.

2. 20mph Speed Limit

No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 20mph in any of the lengths of road set out in schedule 2 to this Order.

3. 30mph Speed Limit

No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30mph in the length of road set out in schedule 2 to this Order

4. Restricted Road

No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30mph in the length of road set out in Schedule 4 to this Order, which shall become a restricted road by virtue of this Order..

5. Exemption

No speed limit imposed by this order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3 (4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3 (5) of those Regulations.

6. Commencement of Order

This Order shall come into force on the 30th June 2014 and may be cited as the "Lancashire County Council (D'urton Lane, Highrigg Drive, St John's Court, Preston, Preston City) (Revocation, 20 and 30mph Speed Limit) Order 2014"

Schedule 1 - Revocation

"The Lancashire County Council, (40 M.P.H Speed Limit) (No. 2) Order 1984" insofar as it relates to "That length of the new link road between the Ingol/East Fulwood Distributor Road, and D'urton Lane".

Schedule 2 – introduction of 20mph speed limit

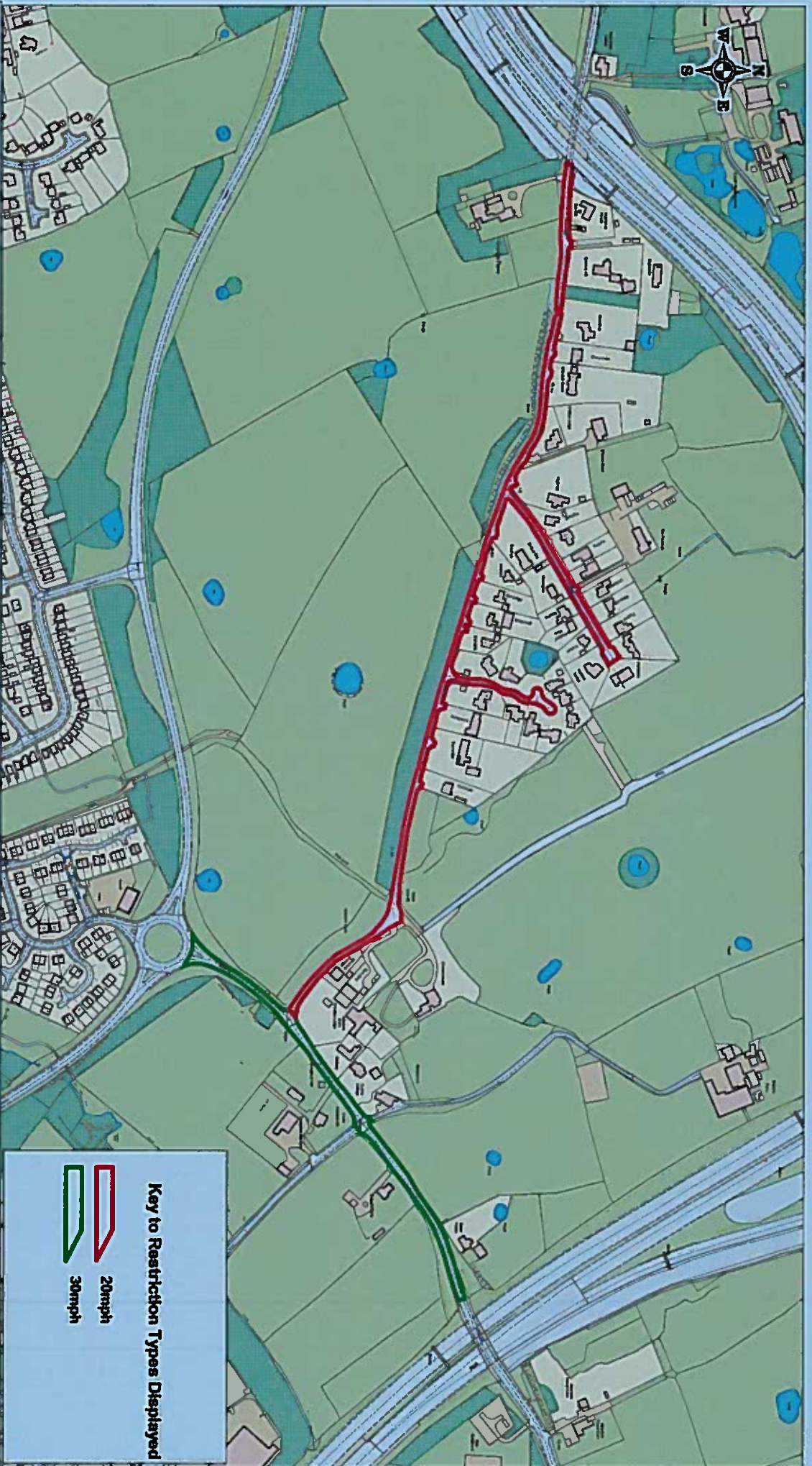
- I. D'urton Lane, from a point 530 metres east of the centre line of Garstang Road for a distance of 884 metres in an easterly direction.
- II. Highrigg Drive, the entire length.
- III. St John's Court, the entire length.

Schedule 3 – introduction of 30mph speed limit

- I. D'urton Lane, Preston, from a point 115 metres south west of the centre line of Midgery Lane to a point 202 metres north east of the centre line of Midgery Lane.

Schedule 4 – introduction of a restricted road

- I. D'urton Lane, from its junction with Eastway to a point 115 metres south west of the centre line of Midgery Lane
