

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (LONGTON AREA, LONGTON (VARIOUS ROADS), SOUTH RIBBLE BOROUGH) (20MPH, RESTRICTED ROAD AND 30MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2013

The County Council of Lancashire, in exercise of its powers under Sections 82(2), 83(2), 84(1)(a) and (2) of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order: -

1. 20mph Speed Limit

No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour on any of the roads or lengths of road set out in the schedule to this Order, located within the Longton Area, South Ribble Borough.

2. Restricted Road (30mph speed limit will apply)

No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour along **Hall Carr Lane** (U1274), Longton, from a point 1370 metres south east of its junction with Marsh Lane for a distance of 748 metres in a south easterly direction to a point 420 metres from its junction with Liverpool New Road which shall become a restricted road (as defined in section 82 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984).

3. 30mph Speed Limit

No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour along:

- i. **Marsh Lane**, Longton, from a point 40 metres west of the centre line of its junction with Back Lane to its end.
- ii. **Hall Carr Lane (U1274)**, Longton, from its junction with Marsh Lane for a distance of 1370 metres in a south easterly direction.

4. Exemption

No speed limit imposed by this order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3 (4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3 (5) of those Regulations.


5. Commencement of Order

This Order may be cited as the "Lancashire County Council (Longton Area, Longton (Various Roads), South Ribble Borough) (20mph, Restricted Road and 30mph Speed Limit) Order 2013" and shall come into force on the 22nd day of July 2013".

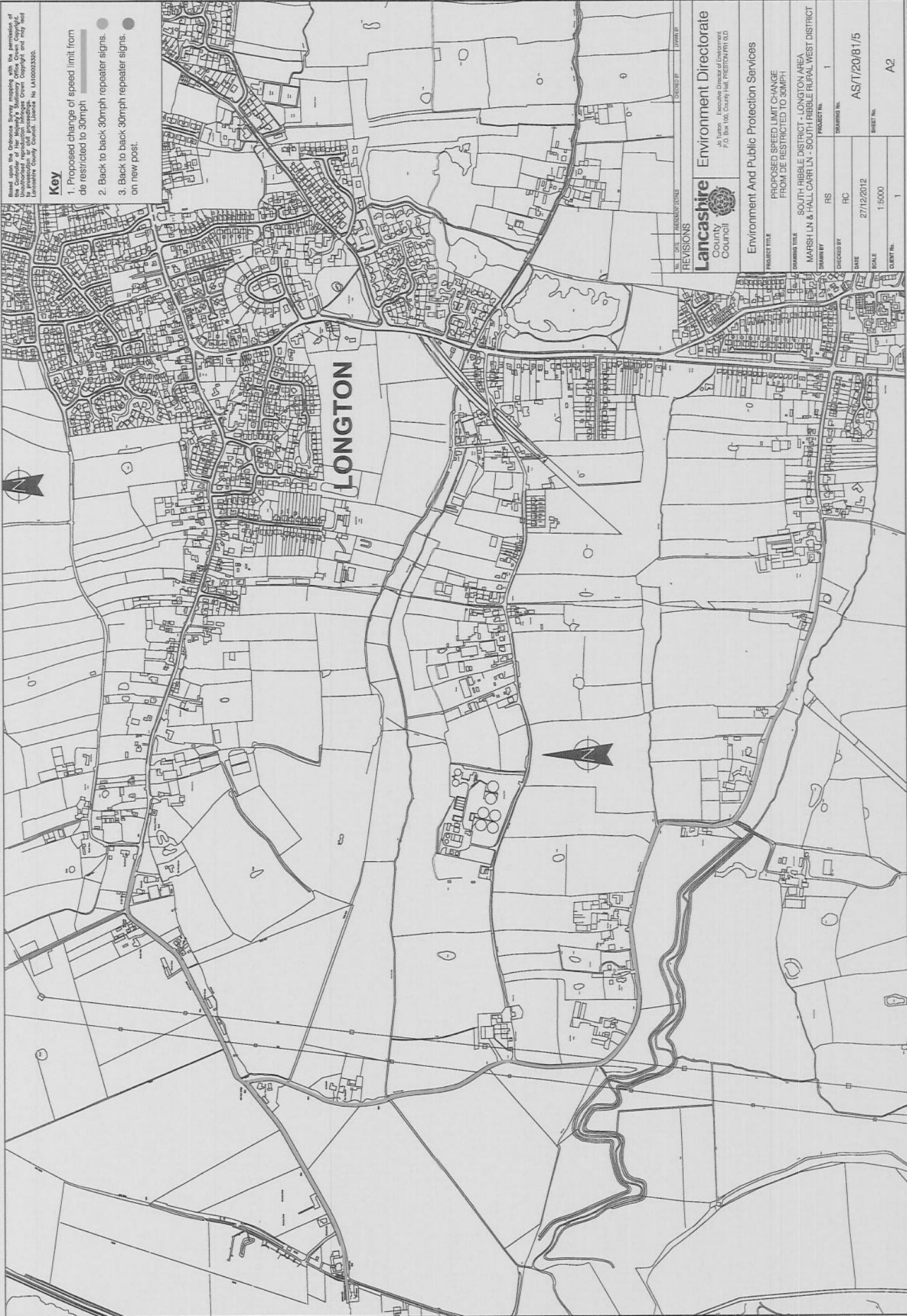
