THE LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (NABS HEAD LANE AND GOOSEFOOT LANE, SAMLESBURY, SOUTH RIBBLE BOROUGH) (SPEED DERESTRICTION AND RESTRICTED ROAD) ORDER, 1998.

The County Council of Lancashire, in exercise of its powers under Sections 82(2) and 83(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

- The length of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order shall cease to be a restricted road for the purposes of Section 81 of the Act.
- The length of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order shall be a restricted road for the purposes of Section 81 of the Act.
- 3. This Order may be cited as "The Lancashire County Council (Nabs Head Lane and Goosefoot Lane, Samlesbury, South Ribble Borough) (Speed Derestriction and Restricted Road) Order 1998 and shall come into force on the 6th May, 1998.

## SCHEDULE 1

Nabs Head Lane, Samlesbury, from a point 84 metres south of the edge of the carriageway of Preston New Road, to a point 20 metres north of the centre of the northerly slip road leading to Spring Lane.

## SCHEDULE 2

Goosefoot Lane, Samlesbury, from its junction with Nabs Head Lane for a distance 80 metres in a south-westerly direction.
