

## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1967 THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF LANCASHIRE (RESTRICTED ROADS)(NO.5) ORDER 1979

PRBE 1979/17 (6)

The County Council of Lancashire in exercise of their powers under Section 72(3) and 73(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 of the Local Government Act 1972 (which said Act of 1967 as so amended is hereinafter referred to as the "Act of 1967") and of all other powers them enabling and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police hereby Order as follows:-

- 1. It is directed that the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order shall become a restricted road for the purpose of Section 71 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended.
- 2. This Order may be cited as the County Council of Lancashire (Restricted Roads)(No. 5) Order 1979 and shall come into operation on the 9th November, 1979.
