The Borough of Preston (Tag Lane)

(Restricted Road) Order 1980

The Preston Borough Council pursuant to arrangements made under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the Lancashire County Council in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under Sections 72(3) 73(1) and 84D(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974 (which said Act of 1967 as so amended is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1967") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Section 84C(1) of the Act of 1967 hereby makes the following Order:-

1. The length of road specified in the First Schedule to this Order shall become a restricted road for the purposes of Section 71 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967
2. The Traffic Regulation Orders specified in the Second Schedule to this Order are hereby revoked
3. This Order may be cited as the Borough of Preston (Tag Lane) (Restricted Road) Order 1980 and will come into operation on the seventeenth day of November 1980

THE FIRST SCHEDULE


That length of Tag Lane within the Borough of Preston which extends from its junction with Bexhill Road to its more northerly junction with Tanterton Hall Road

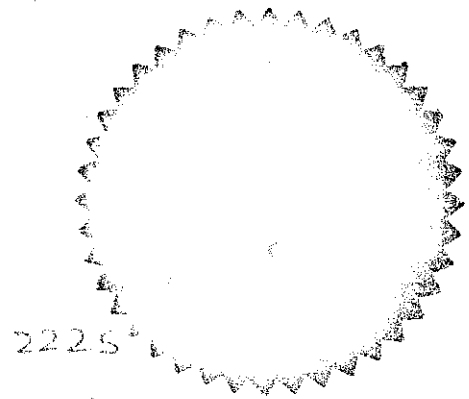
