ROAD TRAFFIC ACT 1960

THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF LANCASHIRE (RESTRICTED
ROADS) (NO. 4) ORDER 1963

The County Council for the County Palatine of Lancaster in exercise of their powers under section 20(3) and section 21(1) of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police for the County Palatine of Lancaster and with the consent of the Minister of Transport, hereby order and direct as follows:-

1. Each of the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Order shall become a restricted road for the purposes of section 19 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960.
2. The Interpretation Act, 1889 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. This Order may be cited as "The County Council of Lancashire (Restricted Roads)(No.4) Order, 1963".

SCHEDULE

- (1) Chapel Lane, Longton, from its junction with Liverpool Road to the eastern boundary of St.Oswald's School.
- (2) Chapel Lane, New Longton, from a point 125 yds. west of its junction with South Avenue to New Longton Station level crossing.
- (3) Station Road, New Longton, from New Longton Station level crossing to its junction with Wham Lane.
- (4) Wham Lane, New Longton, from its junction with Station Road in an easterly direction for a distance of 300 yards.
