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ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1967

The County Council of Lancaster
(Restricted Roads)(No. 3) Order, 1968

The County Council of the County Palatine of Lancaster in exercise of their powers under section 72(3) and section 73(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police for the County Palatine of Lancaster and with the consent of the Minister of Transport, hereby order and direct as follows:-

1. The length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order shall become a restricted road for the purposes of section 71 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967.
2. The Interpretation Act 1889 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. This Order may be cited as the County Council of Lancaster (Restricted roads)(No. 3) Order 1968 and shall come into operation on the fifth day of April, 1968.

SCHEDULE

In the Rural District of Preston in the County Palatine of Lancaster

That length of Liverpool Old Road (Class III) in the Parish of Much Hoole, which extends from the south-easternmost point of the roundabout which forms its junction with the Longton By-Pass (A.59) (in a southerly direction) to its junction with Liverpool Road (A.59), a distance of approximately 1410 yards.
