(STATION ROAD, HOGHTON, CHORLEY BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Station Road, Hoghton from a point 20 metres either side of the Hoghton Level Crossing.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative daily from 2300 hours until 0400 hours from Saturday 29<sup>th</sup> November 2025 until Monday 1<sup>st</sup> December 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Station Road, Hoghton – A675 Hoghton Lane - Station Road, Hoghton

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow railway tamping works to be carried out through the level crossing.
