SYKE HOUSE LANE, GREENFIELD LANE, CHURCH LANE, BULLSNAPE LANE, INGLEWHITE, PRESTON CITY (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over the following lengths of highway;
  - i. Syke House lane from its junction with Inglewhite Road to its junction with Church Lane.
  - ii. Greenfield Lane from its junction with Back Lane to its junction with Church Lane.
  - iii. Church Lane from its junction with Syke House Lane for approximately 40 metres in a northerly direction.
  - iv. Bullsnape Lane from its junction with Syke House Lane for approximately 20 metres in a southerly direction.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0930 hours until 1530 hours on Thursday 6<sup>th</sup> November 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Greenfield Lane – Stoney Lane – Horns Lane – Inglewhite Road – Button Street – Church Lane and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow pole testing works to be carried out.
