ST THOMAS ROAD, PRESTON, PRESTON CITY (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of St Thomas Road, Preston from its junction with Garstang Road, Preston to its junction with St James Road.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0900 hours until 1800 hours on Monday 20th October 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Eastbound Traffic:

Garstang Road – Gallows Hill – St James Road.

Westbound Traffic:

Shuttleworth Road – Gallows Hill – Garstang Road.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow removal of telecommunications equipment to be carried out.
