(COCKERHAM ROAD, COCKERHAM, FORTON, LANCASTER CITY) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) NOTICE 2025

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council consider it necessary because of the likelihood of danger to the public that the prohibition should come into force without delay under **Section 14(2)(b)** of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, which will temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle, cycle or pedestrian to proceed over that length of Cockerham Road for a distance of approximately 15 metres either side of Cockerham Road Canal Bridge (Bridge no79).
- 2. Nothing in this notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0001 hours on Friday 19<sup>th</sup> September 2025 until 1700 hours on Thursday 9<sup>th</sup> October 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Cockerham Road – B5272 Garstang Road – B5272 Park Road – Ratcliffe wharf Lane – A6 Lancaster Road – Cockerham Road – and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow works to make safe following bridge strike and full repair works to be carried out.
