(COCKERHAM ROAD, COCKERHAM, FORTON, LANCASTER CITY)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) NOTICE 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle, cycle or pedestrian to proceed over that length of Cockerham Road for a distance of approximately 15 metres either side of Cockerham Road Canal Bridge (Bridge no79).
1. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
2. The prohibition will be operative from 1701 hours on Thursday 19th October 2025 until 1700 hours on Friday 19th December 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
3. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Cockerham Road – B5272 Garstang Road – B5272 Park Road – Ratcliffe wharf Lane – A6 Lancaster Road – Cockerham Road – and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow works to make safe following bridge strike and full repair works to be carried out.
