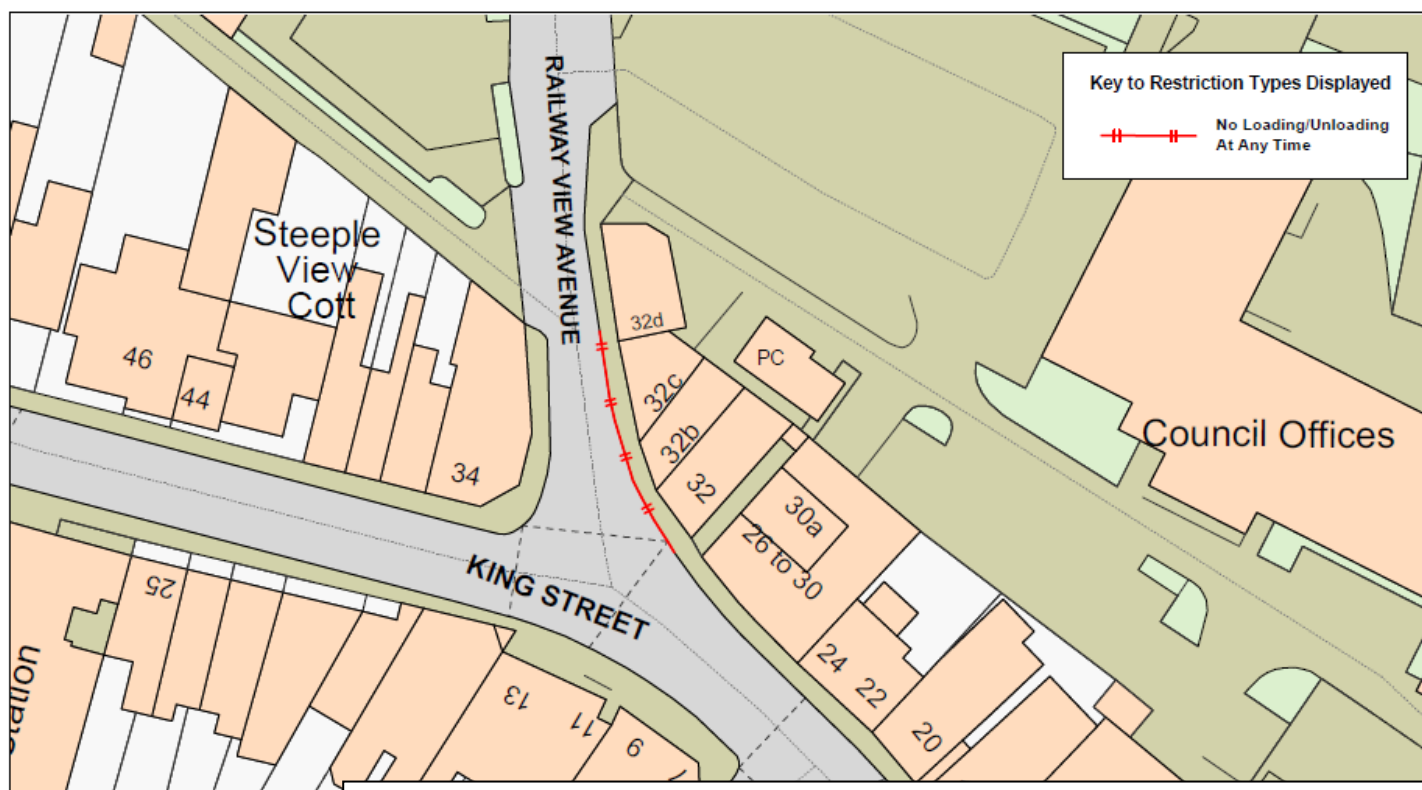


NOTICE OF MODIFICATION
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(VARIOUS ROADS, RIBBLE VALLEY BOROUGH) (VARIOUS
PARKING RESTRICTIONS 25-26 (NO1J)) ORDER 202*



NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council proposed to make the above Traffic Regulation Order under Sections 1, 2 and 4 to the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended. Following consultation carried out between 12 June 2025 and 10 July 2025, it is now intended to modify the proposed Order as titled above, as set out below. Remove Item a) from Schedule 2 and replace with the below.

- a) Railway View Avenue, Clitheroe, the east side, from its junction with King Street, measured along the centreline, for a distance of 24 metres in a northerly direction.

Statement of Reasons

Having reconsidered objections and feedback of the points raised from businesses on Railway View Avenue, it is proposed to make a modification to the consulted proposals to reduce the length of No Loading at Any Time on the east side of Railway View Avenue to a length that is considered necessary to maintain the safety objectives of the loading ban whilst still maintain areas where loading and unloading is permitted.
