

**NOTICE OF PROPOSAL**  
**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**  
**LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**  
**(VARIOUS LOCATIONS, HYNDBURN BOROUGH) (VARIOUS PARKING**  
**RESTRICTIONS (25-26 NO2D)) ORDER 202\***

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council propose to make the above Traffic Regulation Order under Sections 1, 2 and 4 to the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to:

1. Introduce a prohibition of waiting in the following lengths of road:
  - a) Blackburn Road, Oswaldtwistle, both sides, from its junction with the centreline of Buttermere Drive for a distance of 48 metres in a northeasterly direction;
  - b) Spring Street, Rishton, the east side, from a point 3.5 metres southeast of its junction with the centreline of Brook Street for a distance of 12 metres in a south easterly direction.
2. Introduce a restriction of waiting Monday to Friday between 7am and 7pm in Corporation Street, Accrington, the south side, from its roundabout junction with the centreline of Willows Lane for a distance of 17 metres in a south westerly direction.
3. Introduce a restriction of loading and unloading Monday to Friday between 8am and 6pm in Cartmel Avenue, Accrington, the north east side, from a point 83 metres south-east of its junction with the centreline of Broadfield Road around the turning head to a point 95 metres south-east of its junction with the centreline of Broadfield Road.
