
(REAR 14-30 GUILDFORD STREET, BRIERFIELD, PENDLE BOROUGH)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicles to proceed over that length of Rear 14-30 Guildford Street, Brierfield from its junction with Sackville Street to its junction with Rear 1 to 9 Ross Street.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0830 hours on Monday 27th October 2025 until 1600 hours on Tuesday 11th November 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Emergency services will have to follow the diversion. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-
Sackville Street – Albion Street – Ross Street and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow essential works to rectify built over gas main to be carried out.
