DE LACY STREET, PRESTON, PRESTON CITY (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of De Lacy Street, Preston from its junction with Eldon Street to the side of 184 Inkerman Street.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0700 hours on Saturday 25<sup>th</sup> October 2025 until 1700 hours on Sunday 2<sup>nd</sup> November 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

De Lacy Street – Roebuck Street – Inkerman Street and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow new cable connection works to be carried out.
