(SANDY LANE, SKELMERSDALE, WEST LANCASHIRE BOROUGH)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) NOTICE 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council consider it necessary or expedient by reason of works being executed on the following length of road that the prohibition should come into force without delay under **Section 14(2)(a)** of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, which will temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Notice.

1. No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed over that length of Sandy Lane, Skelmersdale from outside number 57 Sandy Lane for a distance of 10 metres in both directions.
2. Nothing in this notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 1545 hours on Monday 29th September until 1600 hours on Friday 3rd October 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. A diversion will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow repair works to a leaking service in footway to be carried out.
