(DEER PARK ROAD, BURNLEY, BURNLEY BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Deer Park Road, Burnley from its junction with Park Bridge Road to its junction with Greenfield Road.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0930 hours on until 1530 hours on Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> December 2025 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained.**
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via: -

Todmorden Road-Harry Potts Way-Brunshaw Road – vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow telecom pole maintenance works to be carried out by Dutton Traffic Management on behalf of Morrison Telecom Services.
