(BACK MOSS LANE, BURSCOUGH, WEST LANCASHIRE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Back Moss Lane, Burscough to a point of 125 metres north of its junction with A59 Moss Lane for a distance of 140 metres in a northerly direction.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0700 hours on Thursday 30th October until 1700 hours on Wednesday 5th November 2025 or until completion of the works within this period. **Due to the nature of the works access for emergency services will not be maintained.**
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will not be maintained.
- 5. There is not an alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure as the road is a no through road.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow excavation works in footway and carriageway to be carried out to install and joint cables for two new services.
