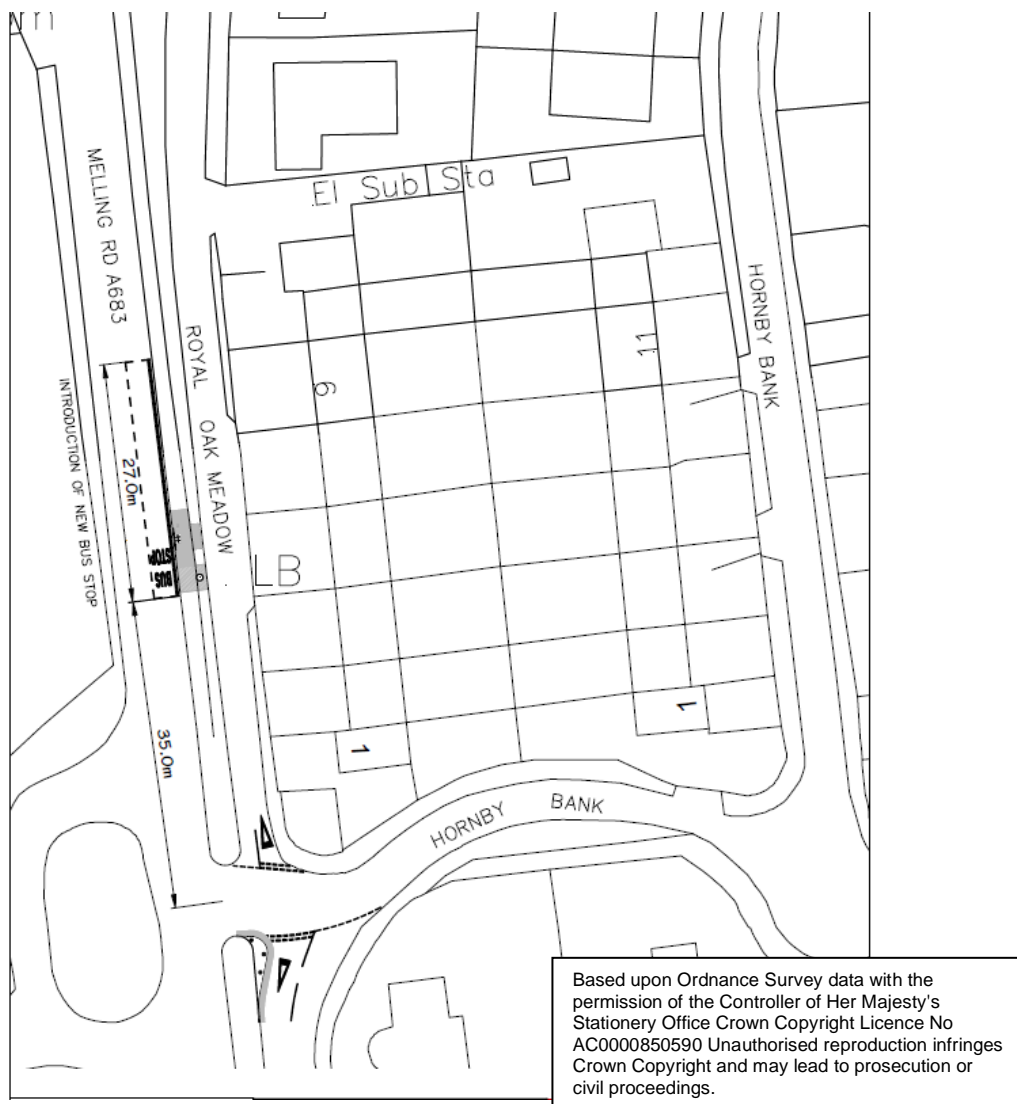


NOTICE OF PROPOSAL
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(MELLING ROAD, HORNBY, LANCASTER CITY) (BUS STOP
CLEARWAY)



NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council propose to introduce a Bus Stop Clearway at any time (the effect of which will be to prohibit the stopping of vehicles) in Melling Road, Hornby, the east side, from a point 35 metres north of its junction with the centreline of Hornby Bank for a distance of 27 metres in a southerly direction.



Statement of Reasons

The purpose of this proposal is to upgrade the existing bus stop on the A683 Melling Road at Hornby, with enforceable clearway markings and signs allowing buses to pull in safely and efficiently at the stop. The proposal intends to promote sustainable transport for all users by including the construction of a raised platform, allowing safe boarding and alighting of passengers. The proposals are being pursued as part of a s278 Agreement under the Highways Act 1980 as part of a new housing development.
