

## Health and safety at the site questionnaire

The Inspector will visit the site and will need to know what safety equipment and protective clothing to bring. The following questions indicate the type of information the Inspector will need about the site and any land or building that the Inspector will need to enter. 1. Is the site uneven or does it present any other known risks? Is special footwear or any other Personal Protection Equipment required, and will this be supplied at the site?

The land crossed by the Order route has been developed and football pitches, a club house and training facility known as Poolfoot Farm constructed. Poolfoot Farm is owned by Fleetwood Football Club and access to the site would need to be arranged with them. It is no longer possible to walk the Order route and any evidence of its previous existence no longer exists. The only section still available to view is the section E-F from Butt's Avenue. There are no known risks associated with inspecting that part of the route.

It is suggested that maps and aerial photographs are looked at in relation to the route and that the PowerPoint presentation submitted as part of the OMA bundle (Doc. 23) together with the route description in the Committee Report are examined.

2. Is there any likelihood of exposure to pets or other animals which may present a risk to the safety of the Inspector?
