## LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

(WHITE HOUSE LANE, GREAT ECCLESTON, WYRE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of White House Lane, Great Eccleston from its junction with Brock Road to its junction with Moss Side Lane.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative daily from 0800 hours until 1600 hours on Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> November 2025 until Thursday 6<sup>th</sup> November 2025 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained.**
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-Hall Lane - Chapel Street - Raikes Road - A586 Garstang Road and Vice Versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow telecom maintenance works to be carried out by Morrison Telecom Services on behalf of BT.
