
NOTICE OF PROPOSAL
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(BLACKBURN BROW AND BOTANY BROW, CHORLEY,
CHORLEY BOROUGH) (BUS STOP CLEARWAY)



NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council propose to introduce a Bus Stop Clearway at any time (the effect of which will be to prohibit the stopping of vehicles) in the following lengths of road:

- a) Blackburn Brow, Chorley, the west side, from a point 0.52 metres south of its junction with the centreline of Knowley Brow for a distance of 34.2 metres in southerly direction;
- b) Botany Brow, Chorley, the south east side, from a point 86.08 metres south west of its junction with the centreline of Knowley Brow for a distance of 27 metres in a south westerly direction.



Statement of Reasons

The purpose of this proposal is to upgrade the existing bus stops on Blackburn Brow with clearway markings, allowing buses to stop safely and efficiently at the stop.

The proposal also includes the construction of a raised boarding platform, allowing safe boarding and alighting of passengers.
