**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council propose the following:

- 1) Remove a bus stop in Blackburn Road, Chorley, the west side, from a point 17 metres south of its junction with the centreline of Gorse Close.
- 2) Introduce a Bus Stop Clearway at any time (the effect of which will be to prohibit the stopping of vehicles) in the following lengths of road:
  - a) Blackburn Road, Chorley, the south west side, from a point 38.2 metres north west of its junction with the centreline of Merton Grove for a distance of 43.4 metres in a north westerly direction;
  - b) Blackburn Road, Chorley, the west side, from a point 27 metres south of its junction with the centreline of Gorse Close for a distance of 27 metres in a southerly direction;
  - c) Blackburn Road, Chorley, the west side, from a point 25.2 metres south of its junction with the centreline of Guildford Avenue for a distance of 44 metres in a southerly direction.

## Statement of Reasons

The purpose of this proposal is to upgrade the existing bus stops with clearway markings on Blackburn Road, allowing buses to stop safely and efficiently at the stop.

The proposal also includes the removal and subsequent relocation of one existing bus stop, to allow for the upgrade.

The proposed upgrades include the construction of a raised boarding platform, allowing safe boarding and alighting of passengers.
