ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (B6601 ROUNDABOUT AND LEAPERS WOOD ROAD, OVER KELLET, LANCASTER CITY) (40 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2022

The County Council of Lancashire, in exercise of its powers under Section 84(1)(a) to the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order: -

1. 40mph Speed Limit

No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40mph on any of the lengths of road as set out in the Schedule to this Order.

2. Exemption

No speed limit imposed by this order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3 (4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3 (5) of those Regulations.

3. Commencement of Order

This Order shall come into force on the 02nd day of May 2022 and shall be cited as the "Lancashire County Council (B6601 Roundabout And Leapers Wood Road, Over Kellet, Lancaster City) (40 Mph Speed Limit) Order 2022".


