

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**  
**LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**  
**(A646 NEW ROAD, BURNLEY, BURNLEY BOROUGH)**  
**(DE-RESTRICTED ROAD) ORDER 2025**

The County Council of Lancashire, in exercise of its powers under Sections 82(2) and 83(2) to the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order: -

**1. De-Restriction**

The length of road as set out in the Schedule to this Order shall cease to be a restricted road for the purposes of Section 81 of the Act.

**2. Exemption**

No speed limit imposed by this order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3 (4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3 (5) of those Regulations.

**3. Commencement of Order**

This Order shall come into force on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of October 2025 and shall be cited as the "Lancashire County Council (A646 New Road, Burnley, Burnley Borough) (De-Restricted Road) Order 2025".

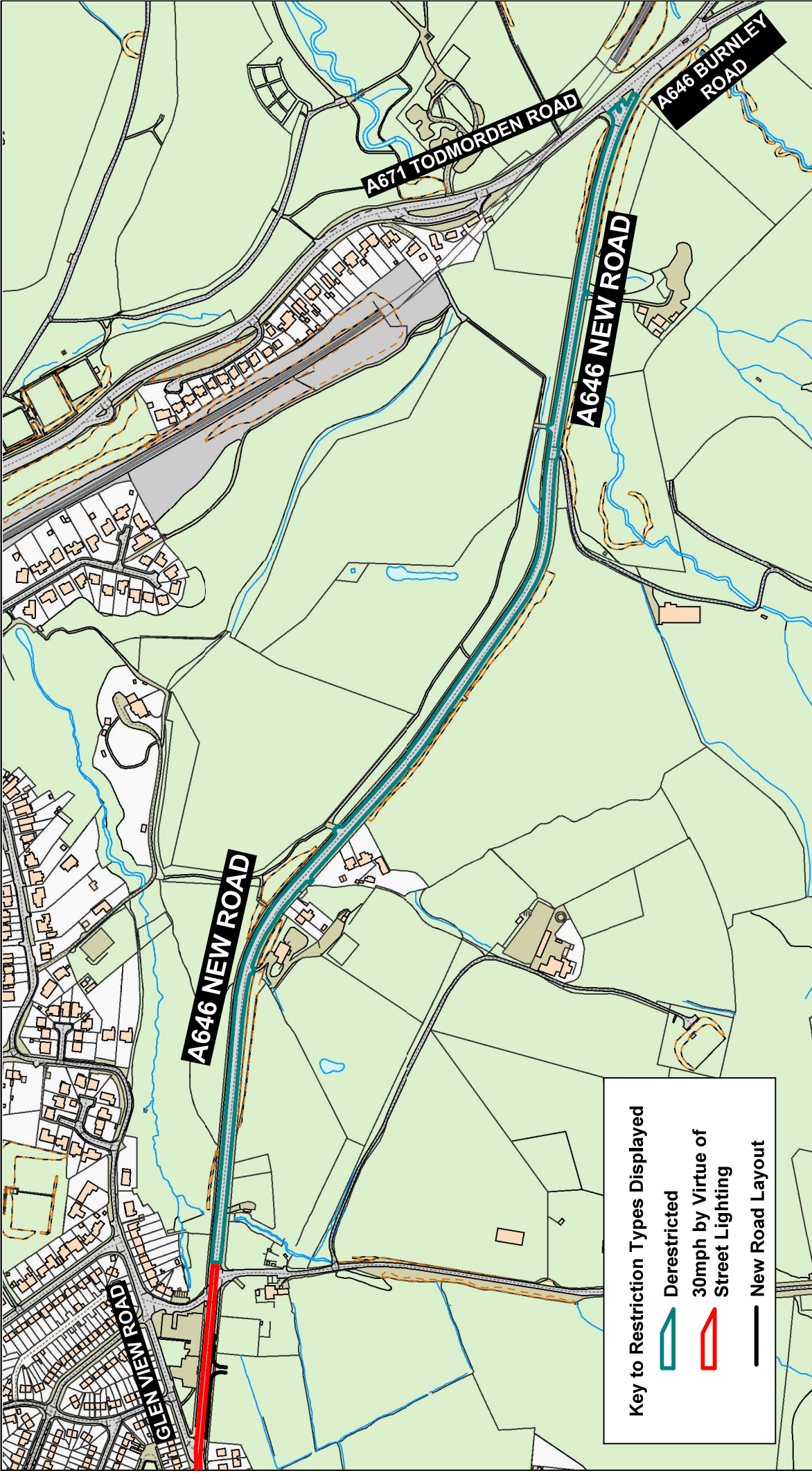
