

NOTICE OF PROPOSAL
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(BURNLEY ROAD, BACUP, ROSSENDALE BOROUGH)
(BUS STAND)



NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council propose the following:

- 1) Remove a bus stand in Burnley Road, Bacup, the west side, from a point 10 metres south east from its junction with the centreline Hall Street for a distance of 22 metres in a south easterly direction.
- 2) Introduce a Bus Stop Stand at any time (the effect of which will be to prohibit the stopping of vehicles) in Burnley Road, Bacup, the west side, from a point 5 metres south east of its junction with the centreline of Hall Street for a distance of 27 metres in a south easterly direction.

Statement of Reasons

The purpose of this proposal is to upgrade the existing bus stop Burnley Road at Bacup, with enforceable markings and signs allowing buses to pull in safely and efficiently at the stop.

The proposal intends to promote sustainable transport for all users by including the construction of a raised platform, allowing safe boarding and alighting of passengers and ensure the bus stops are fully mobility compliant.

The proposals include the repositioning of the existing bus stop to a more appropriate location to take into consideration the widening of Hall Street and the change in use of the building. These changes will necessitate the removal of the existing limited waiting bay.

The proposals are being pursued as part of a s278 Agreement under the Highways Act 1980 as part of a new housing development.
