(BURNLEY ROAD, COLNE, PENDLE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Burnley Road, Colne from its junction with Whitewalls Drive to its junction with Rear 136 -146 Burnley Road in an easterly direction.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- The prohibition will be operative from 0001 hours until 0500 hours on Tuesday 11th November 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Emergency services access will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-Whitewalls Drive – Vivary Way – North Valley Road – Windsor Street – Skipton Road - Craddock Road – Walton Street – Albert Road – Primet Hill – Primet Bridge - Burnley Road

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow telecoms maintenance works to be carried out.
