(MILL HILL LANE, HAPTON, BURNLEY BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Mill Hill Lane, Hapton from its boundary with house number 1 for 300 metres in a westerly direction.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0815 hours until 1600 hours on Thursday 27th November 2025 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained.**
- Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Higher Gate Road – Burnley Road - Manchester Road

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow overhead cable maintenance works to be carried out by Network Plus on behalf of Electricity North West.
