- 1. No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed over that length of B5195 Turnpike Road, Aughton from its junction with A59 Northway for a distance of 30 metres in a westerly direction.
- 2. Nothing in this notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0930 hours on Tuesday 14th October until 1600 hours on Friday 17th October 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. A diversion will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow emergency excavation works to remove a faulty link box to be carried out.
