HOYLES LANE, WOODPLUMPTON, PRESTON CITY (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Hoyles Lane, Woodplumpton from its junction with Sandy Lane to its junction with Broadstone Road.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 27th October 2025 until 1700 hours on Friday 31st October 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Hoyles Lane – Sidgreaves Lane – Avice Pimblett Way – Edith Rigby Way – William Young Way – Tabley Lane – Hoyles Lane and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow surfacing works, markings and traffic calming measures to be carried out.
