MARKET STREET, PRESTON, PRESTON CITY (TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF LOADING/UNLOADING BAY) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF WAITING) NOTICE 2025

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. To temporarily suspend the loading and unloading bay on that length of Market Street, Preston from a point 4 metres south of the centreline of Earl Street for a distance of 25.5 metres in a southerly direction.
- 2. No person shall cause any motor vehicle (except for licenced taxi vehicles) to wait from a point 4 metres south of the centreline of Earl Street for a distance of 25.5 metres in a southerly direction.
- 3. Nothing in this notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 4. The prohibition will be operative from 0001 hours on Saturday 18<sup>th</sup> October 2025 until 2359 hours on Wednesday 14<sup>th</sup> April 2027 or until completion of the works within this period.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow a temporary taxi rank to be set up.
