BOROUGH) (BUS STOP CLEARWAYS)



**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council propose to introduce a Bus Stop Clearway at any time (the effect of which will be to prohibit the stopping of vehicles) in the following lengths of road:

- 1) Duddle Lane, Walton le Dale, the east side, from a point 13 metres south of its junction with the centreline of Danes Drive for a distance of 19 metres in a northerly direction;
- 2) Duddle Lane, Walton le Dale, the west side, from a point 6 metres north of its junction with the centreline of Coniston Drive (southern extent) for a distance of 27 metres in a southerly direction;
- 3) Duddle Lane, Walton le Dale, the north east side, from a point 11 metres south east of its junction with the centreline of Coniston Drive (northern extent) for a distance of 23 metres in a south easterly direction;
- 4) Duddle Lane, Walton le Dale, the north west side, from a point 6 metres north east of its junction with the centreline of Selkirk Drive for a distance of 24 metres in a north easterly direction.

## Statement of Reasons

It is proposed to introduce Bus Stop Clearways to eliminate the obstruction caused by parked vehicles at the kerbside, thereby enhancing the efficiency and reliability of bus journeys.

The aim of the proposals are to ensure the safe movement of both vehicles and pedestrians, while also establishing bus stops that comply with the Equality Act (2010).
