(COPPULL HALL LANE, COPPULL, CHORLEY BOROUGH)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Coppull Hall Lane, Coppull from a point 250 metres in an easterly direction from its junction with Chapel Lane, Coppull for a distance of 365 metres in an easterly direction.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0830 hours on Monday 12th January 2026 until 1630 hours on Wednesday 14th January 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.**
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-
Coppull Hall Lane – Chapel Lane – Green Lane and Vice Versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow telecoms civils works to be carried out.
