(BARDEN LANE, BURNLEY, BURNLEY BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Barden Lane, Burnley from outside property named Barden Lodge to its junction with Lower Manor Lane.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Tuesday 11th November 2025 until 1700 hours on Friday 14th November 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Barden Lane- Colne Road- Clitheroe Road- Cuckstool Lane- Barrowford Road.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow installation of new water connection and disconnect old supply works to be carried out by Network Plus on behalf of United Utilities.
