(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) NOTICE 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council consider it necessary or expedient by reason of works being executed on the following length of road that the prohibition should come into force without delay under **Section 14(2)(a)** of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, which will temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over the following length of highway:
 - a) Robin Hood Lane, Wrightington from its junction with High Moor Lane to where it merges with Moss Lane
 - b) Moss Lane, Wrightington from where it merges with Robin Hood Lane to its junction with A5209 Hall Lane.
2. Nothing in this notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 1300 to 1600 hours on Thursday 23rd October 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. A diversion will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow emergency carriageway repair works to be carried out.
