(BRIDGE STREET, GARSTANG, WYRE BOROUGH)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Bridge Street, Garstang from its junction with High Street to outside number 4.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 5th January until 1800 hours on Friday 16th January 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained.**
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-
SOUTH: Church Street – Park Hill Road – Bridge Street.

NORTH: Park Hill Road – Park Hill Road (One Way) – Croston Road – High Street

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow lining, bollards, kerbing and footpath works to be carried out by Lancashire County Council.
