(HOWGILL LANE, HARDACRE LANE, CROSS HILL LANE AND ROBIN LANE, RIMINGTON, RIBBLE VALLEY) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Howgill Lane, Hardacre Lane, Cross Hill Lane and Robin Lane Rimington as stated in article 3 of this order.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibitions will be operative consecutively and daily from 1st December 2025 until 7th December 2025 as follows: Howgill Lane from 0930 until 1500 hours
 Hardacre Lane, Cross Hills Lane and Robin Lane from 0800 hours until 1600 hours or until completion of the works within this period. The prohibitions will only be operative when indicated on site by the presence of the appropriate traffic signs in accordance with The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained. Access will be maintained for emergency services.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via: -

Howgill Lane – Robin Lane – Cross Hill Lane – Hardacre Lane – Burnley Road **Hardacre Lane, Cross Hill Lane and Robin Lane** – Burnley Road – Howgill Lane

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Morrison Telecom Services on behalf of British Telecom to carry out the installation of telecom pole works.
