(BLACK MOSS LANE, ORMSKIRK, WEST LANCASHIRE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle, cycle or pedestrian to proceed over that length of Black Moss Lane, Ormskirk from the junction with High Moss to the junction with Gore Drive.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative nightly from 2200 to 0500 hours on Monday 1st December until Tuesday 16th December 2025 or until completion of the works within this period. **Due to the nature of the works access for emergency services will not be maintained**
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-Black Moss Lane, Long Lane, B5197 Prescot Road and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow railway bridge works to be carried out.
