(WORSTON ROAD, CHATBURN, RIBBLE VALLEY) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Worston Road, Chatburn from its junction with Whalley Clitheroe Bypass travelling in a northerly direction for approximately 300 metres.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative daily from 0930 hours until 1530 hours on 24th November 2025 until 28th November 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained. Access will be maintained for emergency services.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via: -

Clitheroe Road – Crow Trees Brow – Bridge Road – Sawley Road – Whalley Clitheroe Bypass

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Openreach on behalf of British Telecom to carry out cabling works.
