## LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

(BLACKBURN ROAD, EDENFIELD, ROSSENDALE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Blackburn Road, Edenfield from its junction with Burnley Road to its junction with Esk Avenue.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Tuesday 11<sup>th</sup> November 2025 until 1700 hours on Friday 12<sup>th</sup> December 2025 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained.**
- Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Burnley Road – Bury Road – Haslingden Road - Manchester Road Blackburn Road.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow the installation of 4.5m depth sewer works to be carried out by Quinn Civil Engineering on behalf of Northstone Ltd.
