

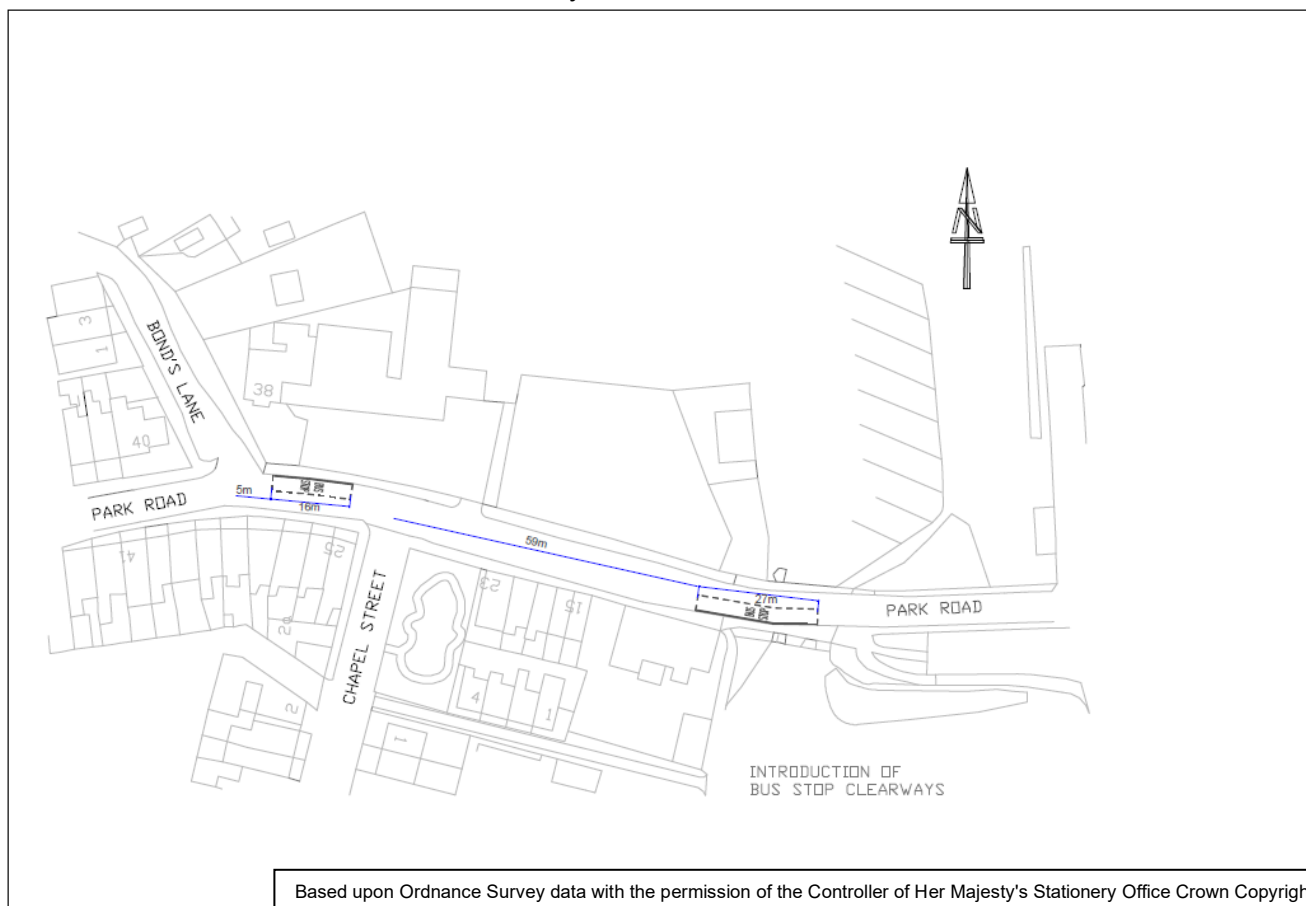
NOTICE OF MODIFICATION
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(PARK ROAD, ADLINGTON, CHORLEY BOROUGH) (BUS STOP
CLEARWAYS)



NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council proposed to introduce the above Bus Stop Clearways. Following consultation carried out between 14 January 2025 and 11 February 2025, it is now intended to modify the proposal as titled above, as set out below.

Introduce Bus Stop Clearways at any time (the effect of which will be to prohibit the stopping of vehicles) in the following lengths of road:

- Park Road, Adlington, the north side, from a point 5 meters east of its junction with the centreline of Bonds Lane for a distance of 16 metres in an easterly direction;
- Park Road, Adlington, the south side, from a point 59 metres east of its junction with the centreline of Chapel Street for a distance of 27 metres in an easterly direction.



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Statement of Reasons

Having considered the consultation responses, it is now proposed to make the following modifications to the consulted proposals with the intention of mitigating the concerns raised.

The modification proposes to relocate the proposed bus stops to the east of the junction with Bonds Lane upgrading the existing east bound bus stop to a quality bus stops and the provision of a new west bound quality bus stop. A raised boarding platform will also be installed at the new east bound bus stop to ensure safe boarding and alighting of mobility impaired passengers and ensure the bus stops are fully mobility compliant.
