SANDY LANE, WOODPLUMPTON, PRESTON CITY

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed over that length of Sandy Lane, Woodplumpton from its junction with Hoyles Lane to its junction with Tyneham Way.
1. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
2. The prohibition will be operative from 0001 hours on Tuesday 4th November 2025 until 2359 hours on Wednesday 12th November 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
3. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Sandy Lane – William Young Way – Tabley Lane – Hoyles Lane and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow completion of the surfacing, road markings and drainage works.
