SANDY LANE, WOODPLUMPTON, PRESTON CITY (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed over that length of Sandy Lane, Woodplumpton from its junction with Hoyles Lane to its junction with Tyneham Way.
- 1. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 2. The prohibition will be operative from 0001 hours on Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> November 2025 until 2359 hours on Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> November 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 3. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Sandy Lane – William Young Way – Tabley Lane – Hoyles Lane and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow completion of the surfacing, road markings and drainage works.
