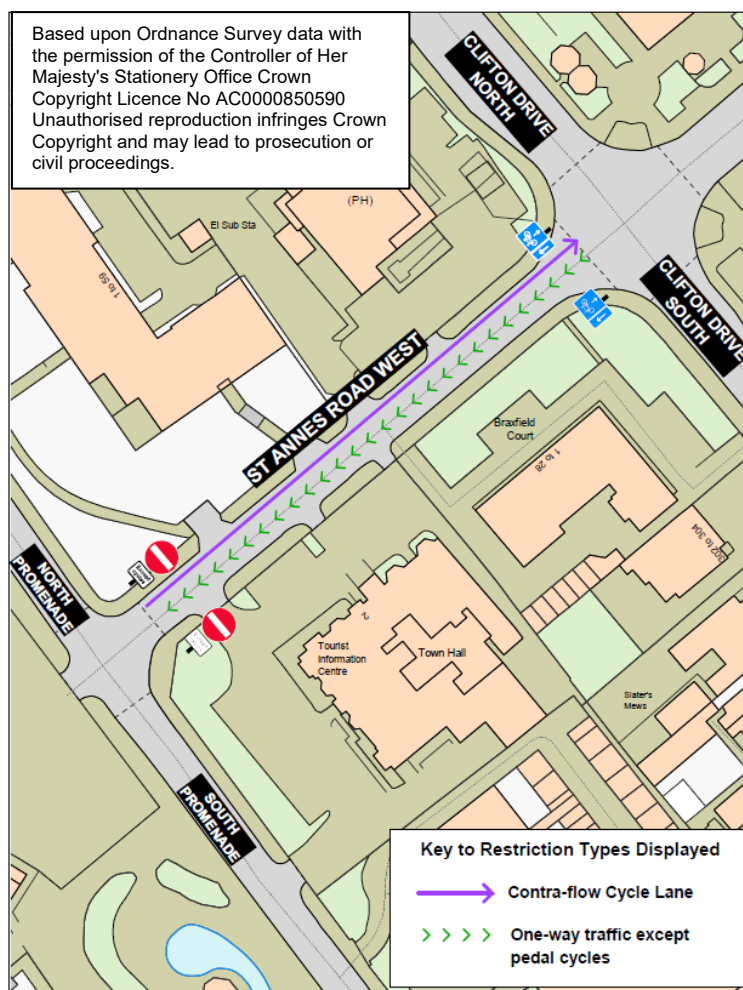


**NOTICE OF MODIFICATION**  
**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**  
**LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**  
**(ST ANNES ROAD WEST, LYTHAM ST ANNES, FYLDE BOROUGH)**  
**(ONE WAY TRAFFIC) ORDER 202\***



**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council proposed to make the above Traffic Regulation Order under Sections 1, 2 and 4 to the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended. Following consultation carried out between 07 August 2025 and 04 September 2025, it is now intended to modify the proposed Order as titled above, as set out below.

- 1) Include an exemption for pedal cycles in the one way restriction in St Annes Road West.
- 2) Introduce a mandatory cycle lane in St Annes Road West, Lytham St Annes, the north west side, from its junction with North Promenade to its junction with Clifton Drive North, south west to north east.



**Statement of Reasons**

Following receipt of feedback after the formal consultation period carried out between 21 August 2025 to 18 September 2025, it is proposed to introduce a contra-flow cycle lane and amend the proposed one-way traffic restriction on St Annes Road West to permit cycle access.

The purpose of these modifications are to address the concerns raised regarding cycle connectivity and to continue actively promoting sustainable travel.

The direction of traffic flows is derived from a study based on the availability of adjacent roads and vehicle volumes.
