

NOTICE OF PROPOSAL
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(VARIOUS ROADS, HYNDBURN BOROUGH) (REVOCATION OF BUS
STOP CLEARWAYS) ORDER 202*

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council propose to make the above Traffic Regulation Order under Sections 1, 2 and 4 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to revoke the following:

- a) "The Borough Of Hyndburn (Bus Stops)(Clearway) Order 1999" in full;
- b) "The Borough Of Hyndburn (Bus Stops)(Clearway) Order 1978" insofar as it relates to a bus stop clearway in the following lengths of road:
 - i. Church Street, Accrington, both sides, for its entire length;
 - ii. Fairfield Street, Accrington, both sides, for its entire length of road;
 - iii. Manor Place, Church, both sides, for its entire length of road;
- c) "The Borough Of Hyndburn (Infant Street, Accrington)(Bus Stops)(Clearway) Order 1980" insofar as it relates to a bus stop clearway 7am - 9am in Infant Street, Accrington, both sides, for its entire length.
- d) "The Borough Of Hyndburn (Peel Street, Accrington)(Bus Stops)(Clearway) Order 1983" insofar as it relates to a bus stop clearway 7am – 9am in Peel Street, both sides, for its whole length together with the full width of the adjoining bus station.
