## Schools Memorandum of Understanding for the Provision of Early Education & Childcare Effective from 1 November 2025

## **Summary of Changes**

The Memorandum of Understanding governing Early Education Funding sets out the terms and conditions applicable to all schools delivering funded early education entitlements. It is essential that participating schools comply with the provisions outlined in this document.

The wording of the Memorandum has been revised to align with the updated statutory guidance issued by the Department for Education earlier this year. While the core funding conditions remain largely unchanged, the revisions primarily clarify the rules concerning charges for additional hours and optional services, including meals, non-food consumables, and extra-curricular activities.

Although the legislation itself has not changed, the updated guidance offers clearer direction for both local authorities and providers regarding the application of additional charges.
